## **Introduction**

Bethlehem Community Church is in the process of extending the *Bethlehem Community Church Centre* at 183 Moffat Road, Bethlehem.

The extensions to the current building will include a *multi-purpose use auditorium and attached canopy* that can seat 250 people and can be used for a range of activities from family and social events, sports activities, choral and dance performances and Sunday worship.

Also, there will be a *multi-purpose use space that we refer to as the Family Building*. This building will open out onto the canopy, grass and playground areas for children once these are developed. This building will include a café area and spaces for groups to use for seminars, social events and breakout areas for children's programmes both on Sunday and during the week.

## **Our Vision**

Bethlehem Community Church aims to serve the Bethlehem community. Our current buildings were opened in 2008 and have been made available to groups associated with Bethlehem Community Church as well as community groups who wish to use them. And we want that to continue and expand.
